## Surver of the New Testament

In 1977, Dr. Jack B. Scott began writing a Bible study series to help church members better understand God's Word, a tool for the discipleship ministry of the local church. The result was the Adult Biblical Education Series (ABES), a 24-volume overview of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, as well as two additional volumes giving an overview of the Old and New Testaments.

Dr. Scott was multi-talented, serving the Lord as a missionary, a pastor, a college and seminary professor, and author of several books besides this series. Dr. Scott's writing displays not only his thorough knowledge of Scripture and Church history, but also his ability to make the Word accessible and understandable to all believers, from the newest to the most seasoned.

The Old Testament and New Testament Surveys give a broad overview of the context and meaning of passages and make ideal companions for daily Bible reading. The complete 24 -volume series provides readers the opportunity to delve deeply into the contextual and covenantal development of Scripture.

Dr. Jack B. Scott went to Korea as a missionary in 1952. There he met and married Eleanor, a missionary nurse. Together they had four children and a life of fruitful ministry. In 1957, they returned to the U.S., where Jack enrolled at Hebrew Union College to study Hebrew. He pastored churches in Kentucky and Mississippi and became one of the founding professors at Reformed Theological Seminary (RTS).

Shortly after celebrating his $57^{\text {th }}$ wedding anniversary, Dr. Jack Scott went home to be with the Lord on June 13, 2011.
